### Background

- UNT was among the earliest institutions invested in promoting open access to scholarly communications and securing our digital legacy.
  - In 2000, the UNT Libraries began thinking seriously about digital preservation (Y2K, Cathy's involvement in GPO and Gov-Info activities)
  - In <u>2000</u> and in <u>2002</u>, we published a couple of peer-reviewed journal articles on the digital preservation issues, including via open access online journals.




