



Background

- **UNT was among the earliest institutions invested in promoting open access to scholarly communications and securing our digital legacy.**
 - In 2000, the UNT Libraries began thinking seriously about digital preservation (Y2K, Cathy's involvement in GPO and Gov-Info activities)
 - In [2000](#) and in [2002](#), we published a couple of peer-reviewed journal articles on the digital preservation issues, including via open access online journals.

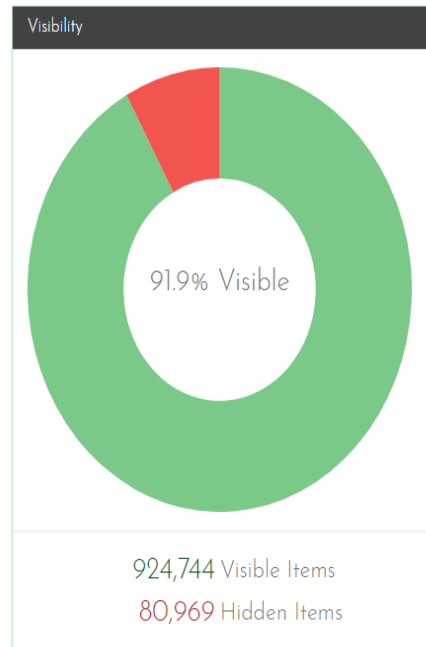
- In 2002, the UNT Libraries began planning The Portal to Texas History.

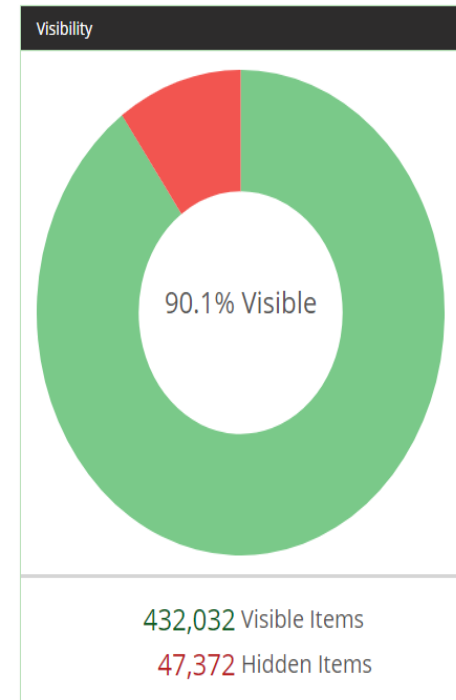
