Formal Senate debate on the Safeguard ABM system began on July 7, 1969, ending in a roll-call vote of 51-49 on August 6. The vote defeated an amendment to the authorization for military procurement, thereby approving deployment of the system. A record of the debate can be found at various pagings of the Congressional Record for the period July 7-August 6, 1969.
