SECTION 3 WEATHER BUREAU WIND SUMMARIES BY COMBINED VELOCITY GROUPS (1139D)

APRIL 1, 1954

These summaries are available for more than 500 stations, principally in Continental U. S. and Alaska but including a few in Canada, the Canal Zone, Cuba, and the Pacific Ocean. For most stations the wind summaries are broken down into 16-point directions, the others to 8 points, depending upon the types of instruments in use at the various stations during the periods of records summarized.

Monthly and annual values are shown in these summaries for most of the stations in the United States, but for the majority of Alaskan stations only the annual summaries were prepared owing principally to the low number of total observations available for these latter stations.

Examples of these monthly and annual wind summaries are shown in Figures I and II, followed by a list of the stations and the periods of record for which they are available.
