Strontium-90 Pilot Production (R. W. Schaich) (Production and Inventory Accounts)

1. Process Status

Three 90 Sr heat sources containing 800 W_t $\pm 5\%$ each were fabricated for Teledyne-Isotopes. These units were loaded into thermoelectric generators and shipped to the customer during September. The 20,000 curie heat source will be fabricated in October for SNAM Progetti, Italy.
