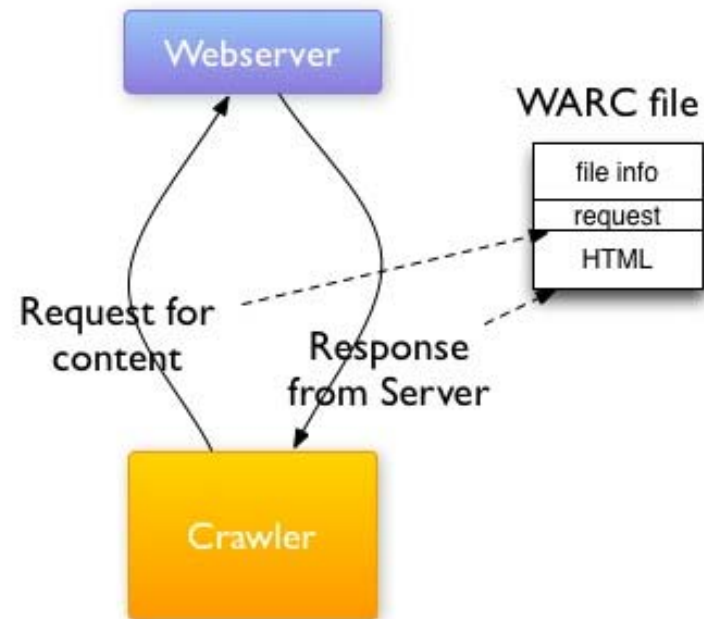

As the crawler requests each part of the webpage from a web server it records everything it requests and everything it receives into a WARC file
