





- Context matters
 - Factors of influence are not similar for both cases
 - Canada: Demographics
 - Finland: Economic threat and Religiosity

Potential areas in the intersection of language endangerment/political instability interesting to your research

- Linguistic vitality influences conflict intensity.
- Perceived linguistic threat among minorities influences support for secession and national attachment.
- Perceived cultural threat among a linguistic minority and a linguistic majority influences intergroup attitudes.
