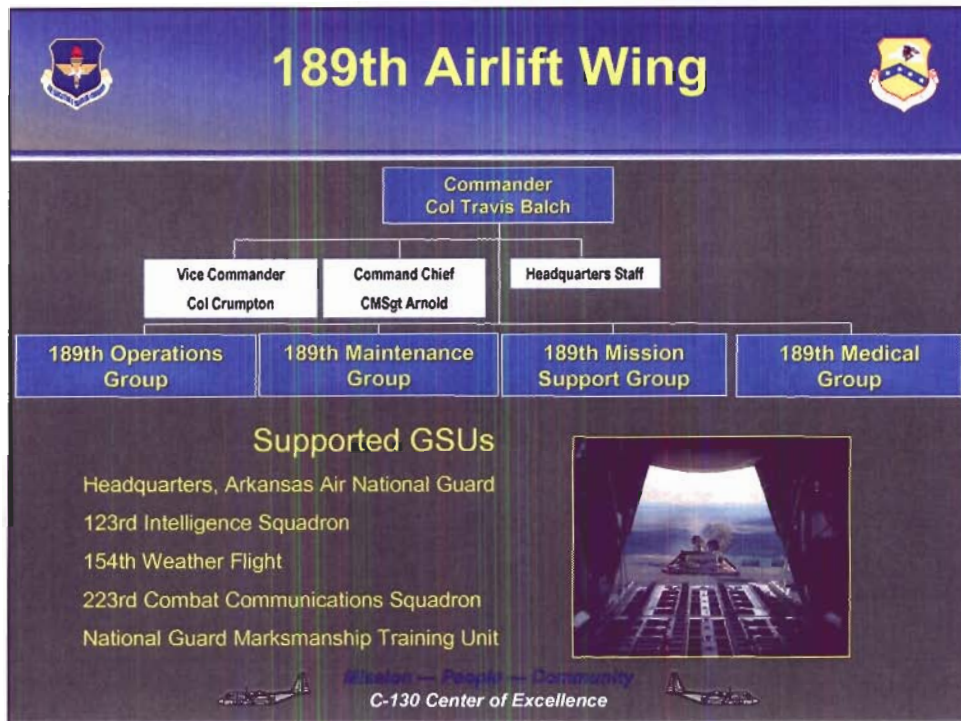

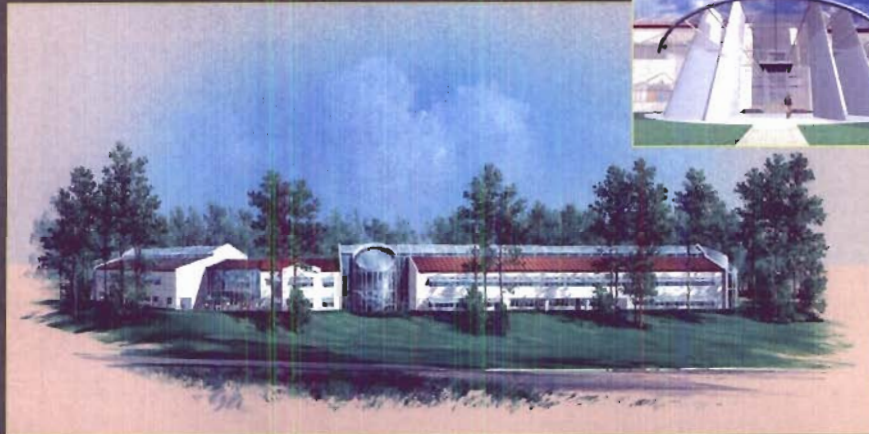

## LRAFB Education Center



- \$9.8M MILCON in FY08-11 FYDP
- Provides 55,220 SF of Modern Classrooms and Offices for 6 Colleges
  - General, Science and Computer Classrooms
- Relocates Operations to Base Property near US Highway 67/167
  - Permits Greater Community Enrollment without Students Entering the Base (Force Protection)
- Jacksonville Raising \$5M for a Follow-On Project for Additional Classrooms (Approx. 26,000 SF)

## New AAFES Mall

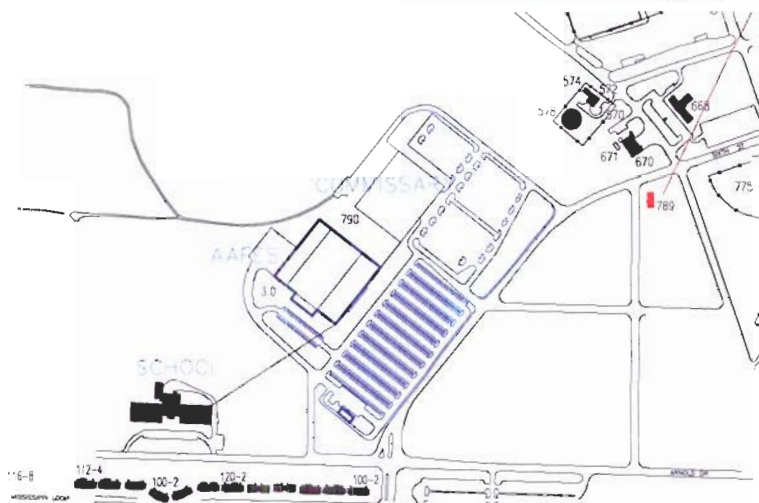


- 122,000 SF Mall; PA is \$10.2M
  - New BX, Clothing Sales, 17 Additional Service or Concession Activities, Food Court with 5 Occupants
  - Location is Adjacent to Existing Commissary
- Site-Specific Design Starts July 2005
- AAFES Expects Congressional Approval Oct-Nov 2005; Construction Should Begin a Few Months Later.
- AAFES will Return Bldgs. 940, 960 and a Portion of 988 to the Base
