MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Terrorist Threat – Military Value Question 1902

1. The purpose of the memo is to provide the scoring plan used for Military Value question 1902.
2. DFAS used the Safety, Protection, Infrastructure, Recovery Integration Team (SPIRIT) report to rank their site in the seven requested areas. The areas were ranked in the following categories – low, low/moderate, moderate, and high. The following point value for each category was used:

Low - 1 point
Low/moderate - 2 points
Moderate - 3 points
High - 4 points

The point value was assigned to each category and the total point value for each location was determined. If the total points added to:

Less than 11 - the overall rating was low
11 to 17 - the overall rating was low/moderate
18 to 24 – the overall rating was moderate
25 and above – the overall rating was high

3. DFAS SPIRIT reports for Mechanicsburg, Red River, and Southbridge were not accomplished or in the case of Kansas City the report did not contain the needed data. (See enclosed Data Clarification Response.) Based on the lack of the SPIRIT reports and the time required to produce reports, the mean of the 26 reporting locations (low) was used at these 4 locations.

2. Question DoD #1902 Terrorist Threat Assessment Rating

The HSA JCSG recognizes that DFAS normally defines the following 24 locations: Arlington, Cleveland, Columbus, Denver, Kansas City, Indianapolis, Charleston, Dayton, Lawton, Lexington, Limestone, Norfolk, Oakland, Omaha, Orlando, Pacific, Pensacola, Rock Island, Rome, San Antonio, San Bernardino, San Diego, Seaside, and Saint Louis. Based on your responses to the Capacity Data Call #1, the HSA JCSG has included the following additional locations: Cleveland Bratenahl, Mechanicsburg, Patuxent River, Pensacola Saufley Field, Red River Army Depot, and Southbridge.

For Question DoD #1902, we received N/A for each data element for Kansas City and no responses to any data elements for Mechanicsburg, Red River Army Depot and Southbridge. Please provide the terrorist threat assessment ratings for these locations. Additionally, if not available, provide rationale explaining why the location does not have a terrorist threat assessment rating.

DFAS RESPONSE:

No terrorist threat assessment ratings exist for Mechanicsburg, Red River Army Depot, and Southbridge. Ratings do not exist for following reasons:

Mechanicsburg. DFAS has only one employee at this location.

Red River Army Depot. This is an Army location.

Southbridge. DFAS has no personnel at this location. I
