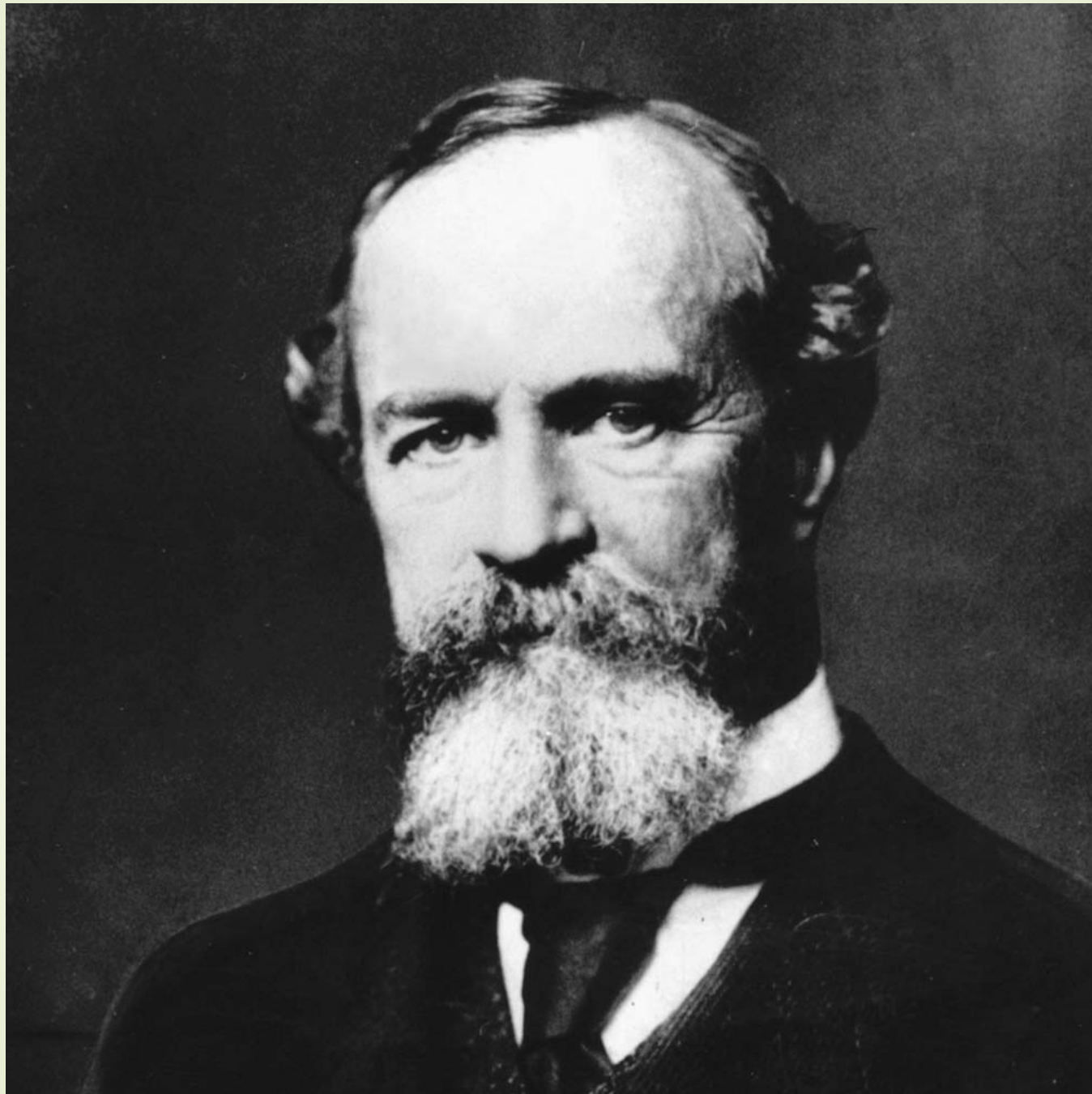

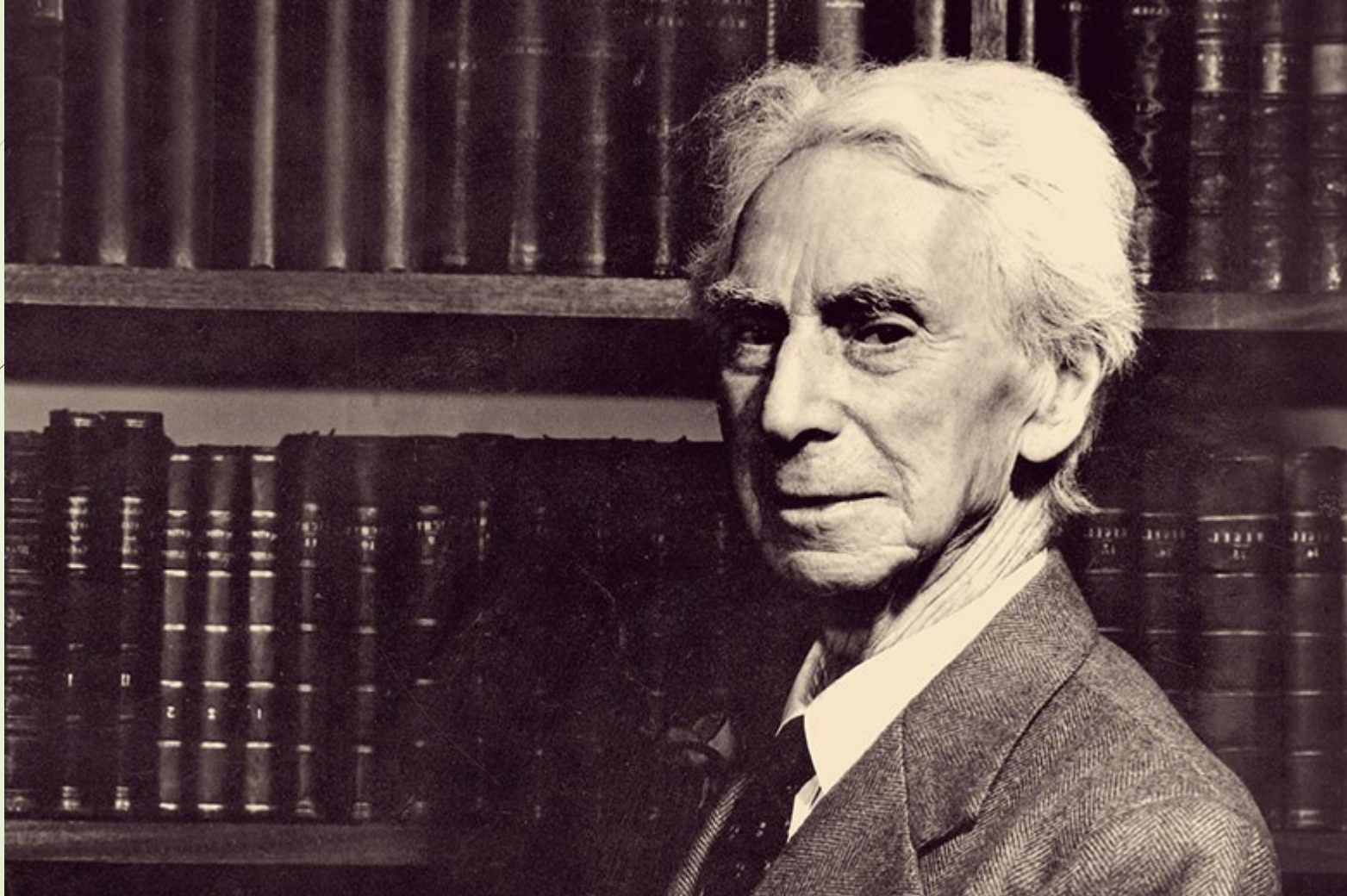

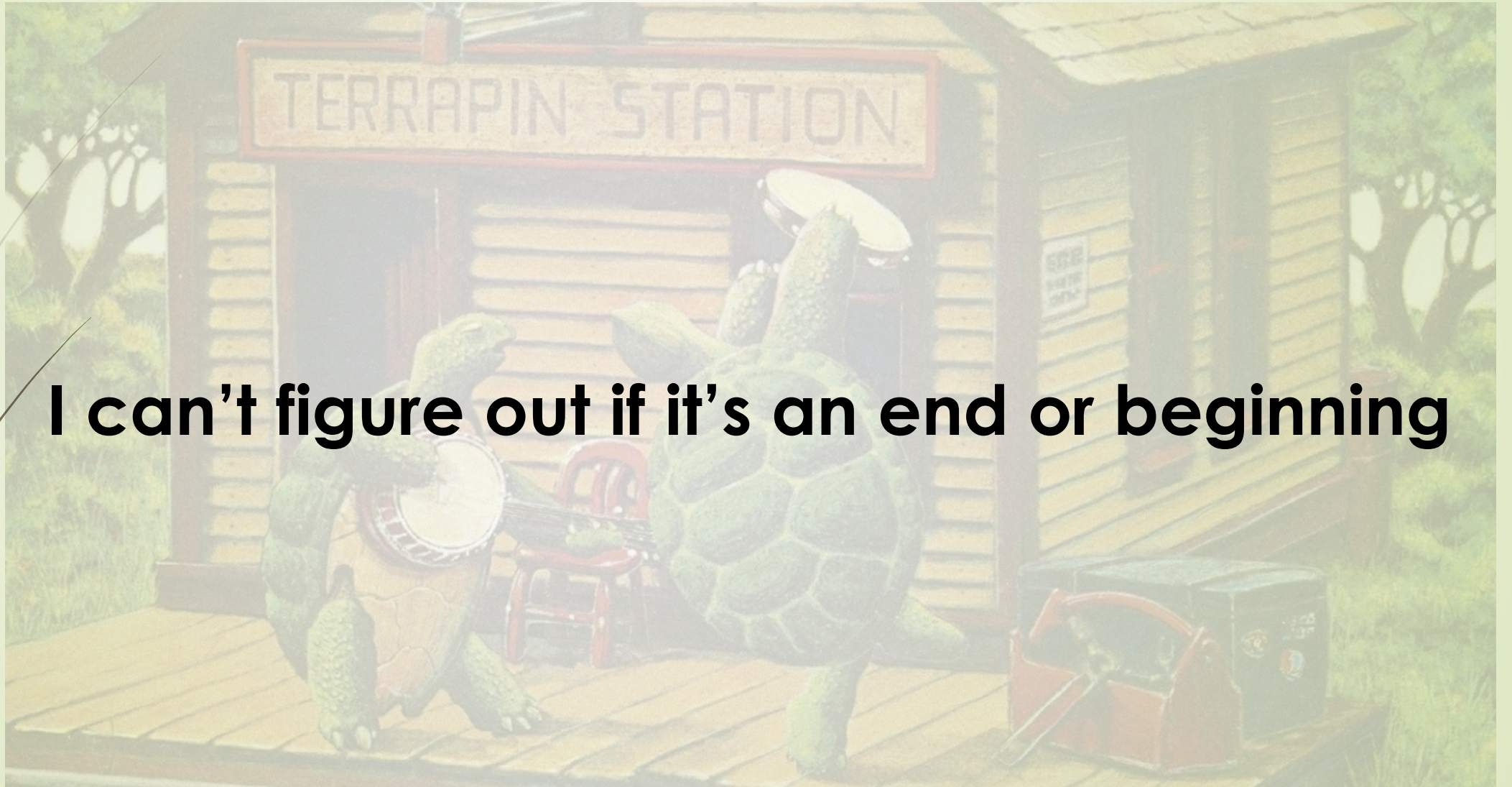












I can't figure out if it's an end or beginning

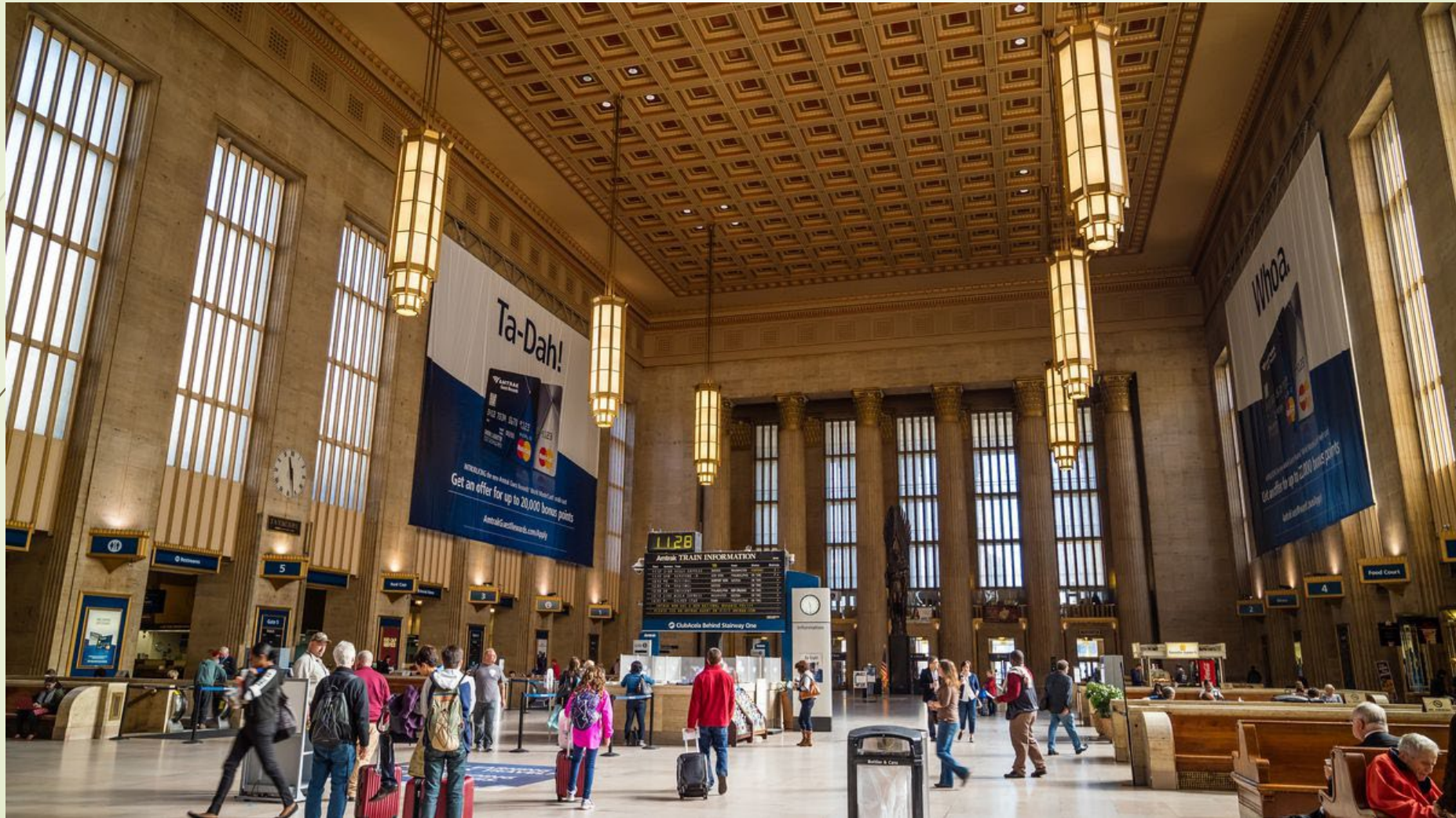


But the train's got its brakes on
