UNT's Collection Development:

The Collection Development
Department identifies appropriate
scholarly resources, acquires or
licenses the use of library
materials, and performs collection
assessments.

Systems and Tools

Sierra (Integrated Library System), Adobe, OCLC, ExLibris, Microsoft Office, and more.

Material Process

Process books, check in periodicals, place property stickers and route material.

Verify and edit fields for music scores, LPs, and EPs.

Communication

Claim late or missing materials through suppliers or directly with publishers.

Open and route materials to staff at the Annex.

Identify and distribute catalogs to subject librarians.

Edit and Verify Information

Update holdings for books and periodicals in OCLC.
Check subscription status and running of E-journals.
Create minimal bibliographic records for art books.
Receive and update information for newly acquired firm orders.
