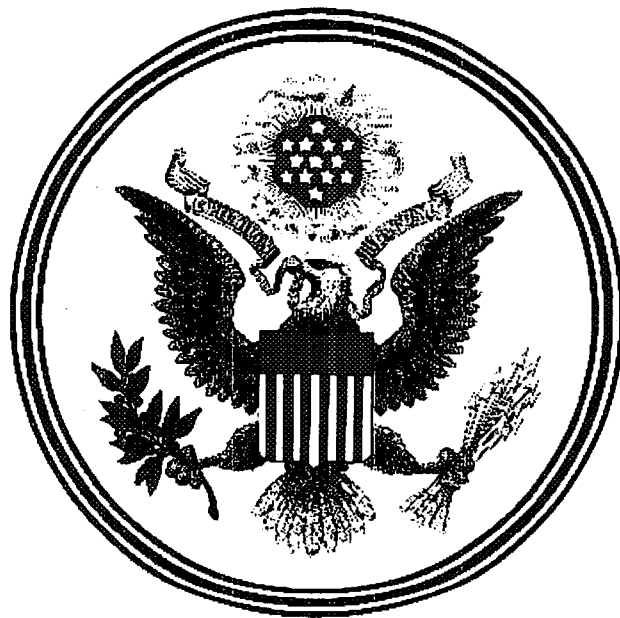

INTRODUCTION: Gov Schwarzenegger, Leon Panetta, Donna Tuttle
California Council of Base Support and Retention

- > Tuttle: huge inland ranges + offshore; D+T new weapons; huge + tech support; missile systems; post-grad school;
- > Governor: huge geography appropriate; satellite tech; enemy to the west.
- > Panetta: happy with 12C/12R/12Gainers; quiet rounds, total 30% + 100K jobs

SENATORS: Jim Inhofe (Feinstein) and Alton Garrett (Boxer)

- > Feinstein: cost of last closure underfunded -> extended closure times.
- > Boxer: land/sea/air training assets - desert + high desert - unencroachment.
* 5 sites on topic list and still not closed.

RIVERBANK ARMY AMMUNITION DEPOT — City of Riverbank

- > Mayor Chris Cifasi — o unique cartridge case maker
- > John Maniatakis — EVP, NI o Operated by ~~house~~ Industries (NI)
- > Unifed WU — Gen Mgr o unique "deep draw" cartridge — up to 5" cartridge
- o huge machines — could break down & move —
- o move = disruption in production
- o equip — either modernized or upgraded along the way.

MARINE CORPS RECRUIT DEPOT + NAVY BROADWAY COMPLEX:

Gen Hoar — keep 2 — Paris Isl cannot handle ↑ workload — firing range not expandable.
 Gain 21K (> 1/2 annually) — each Marine's long longer than USA, USN.

Julie Meier Wright — wants "land sale \$ to go to USN to build new HQ" & lease sites

Congress people Elton Gallegly and Lois Capps: Navy Supply Corp School — NSCS.

Move NSCS to Navy OCS at Newport.

PT MUG } AEA — Airborne Electronic Attack to China Lake — needs expert tech & rapid response.
 CL would have to run the sea range & shuttle targets back & forth. Brain drain. MV off
 EW systems disruption. Reworked CBRN shows ↑ costs and no savings even at 100 yr +
 JOINTNESS will be lost if moved to CL under one service. Tech JCSG awful.

Econom: Used MSA ^{Reverse side} San B _{Ontario} not Barstow but 0.1% but 8% when corrected
 Leave Range alone
