### Open Access (OA) is:

- unrestricted access
- available online
- peer reviewed
- published research

### Open Access (OA) is:

- free to download
- free to share
- free of most copyright and licensing restrictions

### Most copyright and licensing:

- copyright is still held by authors and/or publishers
- licensing may apply
  - Creative Commons (CC)
  - Attribution/Reuse

### **Article Processing Charge (APC)**

- AKA: Open Access Publishing Fees
- fee paid to publishers to make an article free to access\*

\*Not necessarily Open Access

### **Article Processing Charge (APC)**

- optional
- fee paid to publishers for full access
- only through publisher website
- not necessarily "Open Access"

### **Full Open Access**

- unrestricted,online
- free to download
- free to reuse and share

### **Publisher APC**

- unrestricted,online
- free to download
- restrictions for reuse and sharing

### **OA Journals**

- online access
- free to download
- no subscription
- may charge APC
- free to share

### **Hybrid Journals**

- online access
- free to download
- subscription-based
- APCs apply
- Reuse and share restrictions apply

### **Versions of Work**

- Preprint
  - submitted version
  - not peer-reviewed
- Post-print
  - accepted manuscript
  - peer-reviewed
- Final PDF
  - publisher's PDF

#### **Green Open Access**

- free user access
- repository hosted
- preprint or post-print
- no associated APCs

### **Gold Open Access**

- free user access
- publisher hosted
- final PDF version
- charges APC

### **Three Main APC Funding Sources**

- 1. Author pays
- 2. Author's research funder pays
- 3. Author's institution pays

#### Research

- Built on SPARC initiatives\*
  - 15 OA Journals
  - 12 Hybrid Journals

\*Scholarly Publishing and Research Coalition

#### Reviewed

- Licensing Policies
- Reuse and Sharing
- Average APCs


### **Creative Commons (CC) Licensing**

- 15 OA Journals Reviewed
  - 14 allow a CC license
  - authors choose which CC license

### **Average APCs**

- 15 OA Journals' APCs
  - Range: \$695 \$5000
  - Average: \$2000

#### **OA Journal APCs**




### **Creative Commons (CC) Licensing**

- 12 Hybrid Journals Reviewed
  - 8 allow a CC license
  - type of CC license not specified

### **Average APCs**

- 12 Hybrid Journal APCs
  - Range: \$645 \$5000
  - Average: \$2600



- University libraries
- Other
- Co-Sponsorship



- Other

- Not Co-sponsored
- Co-sponsored







- OA Journals
- Hybrid Journals
- Stipulations

#### Supported Journal Types Hybrid with Stipulations





- **■** Hybrid Journals
- Hybrid Journals with Stipulations

### **OA Journal Stipulations:**

- Peer-reviewed
- Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ)
  - Member of Open Access Scholarly Publishing Association (OAPSA)
  - Or follow OAPSA code of conduct


### **Hybrid Journal Stipulations:**

- Peer-reviewed
- No embargo period
- Author retains certain rights to work
- Subscription discount
- Author can self-archive
- Less funding for Hybrid Journals

### 3. Author Eligibility

- University Rank
- Affiliation to university

#### **Eligibility by University Rank**




#### **Eligibility by University Affiliation**

- Currently affiliated
- Individually apply
  - does not include co-authors
  - reimbursement is equally divided
    - Example:
    - \$1200 APC = \$400 for each author


#### 4. Reimbursement Criteria

- Caps on Funding
  - author cap
  - article cap
- Stipulations

Caps on Author Funding Caps on Article Funding



- Cap on Authors
- No Cap



- Cap on Articles
- No Cap

#### Stipulations

- First-come, first-serve basis
- Funding institution listed first on author affiliations
- Must seek grant-funding first
- Must include article in IR

### Challenges & Next Steps

#### **Double Dipping**

- Publisher charges APC on top of normal subscription fee
  - Funder/Institution pays APC
  - 2. Funder/Institution pays subscription

**Conduct** research



Pay Subscription



Pay APC



**Publish** research



#### Campus Open Access Funds

- Limited Funding
- Staffing/management of funds
- Requirements to include a copy in author's institutional repository (IR)

- Publisher policies
  - frequently change
  - limit reuse and sharing
- Limited transparency
  - publishing contracts
  - APC fee contracts
