- All clips integrated into class lectures





- Transitioning to 100% online








## Example World Cultures Through Film

- Starting Pointing immediate needs
  - Faculty creating online courses
  - Classrooms with technology changes
  - Library reserves
- Next
  - Faculty using physical media in instruction
  - New faculty
  - Faculty not currently using media
